On average, every minute of every day, someone in Canada needs blood. Across Canada, 85,000 new blood donors are needed this year to help meet the growing hospital demand for blood.

Healthy people can donate blood every 56 days between their 17th and 71st birthday (regular donor) or between 17th and 61st birthday (first-time donor). To continue donating after their 71st birthday, regular donors should contact Canadian Blood Services prior to donation for further eligibility information.
